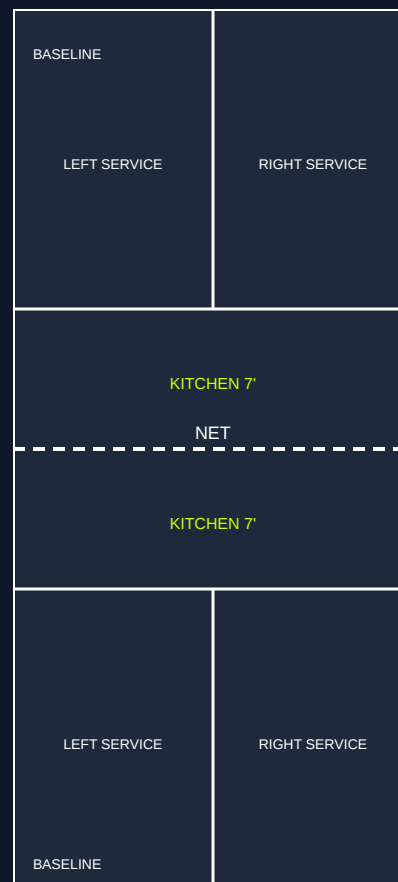


# Court Checklist & Diagram

Print or save this page – everything you need to inspect and remember a pickleball court.



Court 20×44 ft | Kitchen 7 ft | Net 34" center / 36" sides

## Pre-Play Inspection Checklist

- Net height: 34" at center, 36" at posts
- All lines visible, 2" wide, no missing sections
- No large cracks, debris, or wet spots on surface
- Kitchen exactly 7 feet deep from net
- Clearance: at least 7 ft behind baselines, 4 ft beside sidelines
- Net posts padded or capped
- Surface free of moss, algae, or loose particles

## Key Measurements

<b>Total court size</b>	20 ft wide × 44 ft long
<b>Kitchen depth</b>	7 ft from net on each side
<b>Net height</b>	34" at center / 36" at posts
<b>Line width</b>	2 inches (all lines)
<b>Recommended clearance</b>	7 ft behind baselines, 4 ft beside sidelines
<b>Ideal playing area</b>	30 ft × 60 ft
